

Bangladesh playing Gaspar Correia in the first game of the evening, won the toss and elected to bat.

They put on 123 runs for the loss of 3 wickets, with Shaqib (21*), Rajack (21*) and Kholil (17) making most of the runs. In reply Gaspar Correia matched the required run rate until the final over only to come up 1 run short, having lost only 2 wickets en route. Silkesh (21*) and Anish(15) were the main contributors.

Oeiras took on Kings of Punjab in the second game. Oeiras, won the toss and batted first. Oeiras put on 135 runs for 3 wickets with Shurma (21*), P. Buccimazza (36*) and Thapa (16*) were the main contributors. In response, Kings never managed to match the required run rate and as a result ran out of wickets in the 9th over for 108 runs, losing by 27 runs. Their only batsman to make a significant contribution was Pinder (31).
